

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING PARK UTILITIES

WATER: If we lose electrical power for the water plant, we have a propane generator in place to maintain water supply as long as the propane lasts. Thus, if electrical power lines are not working, we will be turning the water on approximately between 7 and 9 AM and again between 5 and 8 PM, if it is safe for our staff. If not safe for them, we will turn it on during breaks in the hurricane winds. Please fill up your water containers, bathtubs and sinks with water. As soon as the power comes back on, Please remember that sediment **MAY** enter the water supply system, so please boil drinking water for at least a week.

TREES: if you have trees on your yard that are near main power lines and your connections to them, please cut them down **NOW** before they break your or the power company's electrical lines. If the main lines break, power may be off for an extended period of time until Centerpoint Power (who own and maintain the high power lines) can get out to repair them.

SEWER: If electrical power is lost, the sewer plant will not work. Once power is lost, **PLEASE** do not flush. Please use a bucket and trash cans for solid waste and deposit into the dumpsters until power is restored. Continuing to flush and drain water into the drain lines will certainly result in back-ups into your homes which could become unhealthy!

TIE DOWNS: If your home is a wind zone 1 and has only a one strap system from the ground to your home, please add straps now!

WINDS: PLEASE USE GOOD JUDGMENT AND SECURE YOUR ROOFS, WINDOWS AND DOOR. PLEASE TIE DOWN OR STORE INSIDE YOUR HOMES ALL LOOSE TOYS, BIKES, LAWN MOWERS, PATIO CHAIRS AND TABLES, ALONG WITH ANY OTHER OBJECTS THAT CAN POTENTIALLY DAMAGE HOMES, VEHICLES &/OR PEOPLE. IF YOUR PERSONAL PROPERTY DAMAGES NEIGHBORS, THEY MAY BE ABLE TO HOLD YOU RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR DAMAGE.

TRASH: During the storm, the Waste Management company will likely **NOT** be picking up the trash in the dumpster bins during their normal M, W, F, Sa schedule. **PLEASE** refrain from throwing garbage and trash on the ground near the bins since, as the garbage floats through the park, that will contaminate the entire park and create a potential health hazard for all.
